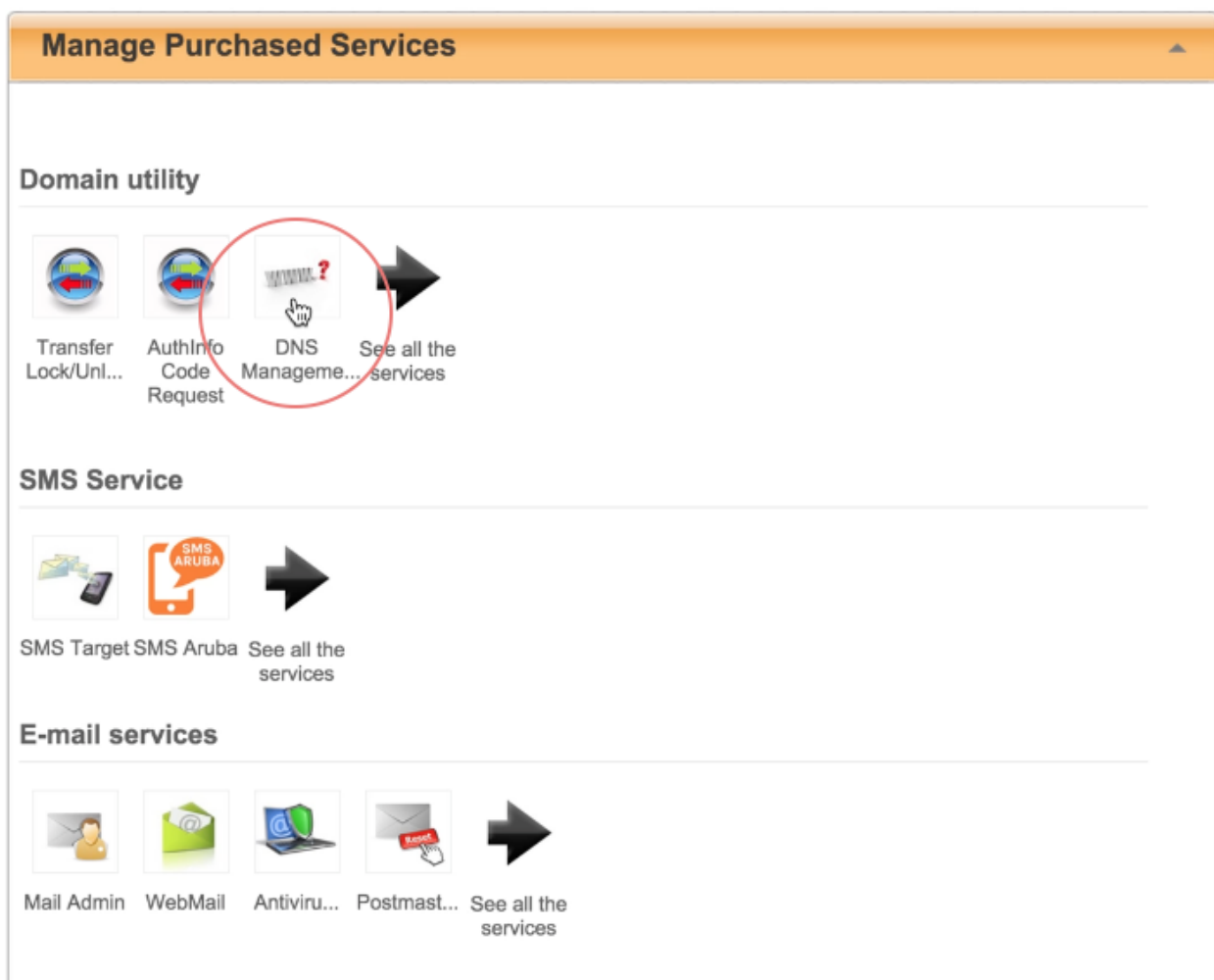

## Use an Aruba Domain With Your Viewbook Account

**1** - Log in to your Aruba account and click “DNS Management” button in the “Manage Purchased Services” box. It’s under the “Domain utility” heading.



**2** - Choose the domain name you want to use. When you see the big page of DNS records, go to the “A Records” heading, and click the manage button.
